### Course Description

This course prepares the trainee prior to taking the City and Guilds NPTC Level 3 Safe Use of Veterinary Medicines Certificate of Competence qualification for managers and supervisors, which comprises a generic knowledge based assessment and practical assessment based on the Animal Health Management Plan. The NPTC Level 2 Safe Use of Veterinary Medicines must be taken prior to taking this award.
