### Equipment required

Trainees to bring steel toe capped boots and overalls. If course delivered at own venue requirements are —a tractor in good safe working order equipped with drawbars, pick up hitches and 3 point linkages, trailer equipped with pick up, hitch drawbar, trailed implement and mounted machine. Also required are tyre pressure gauge, pump, coolant, grease/gun, oils and operating manual for the machine.

A warm room with power supply to run a video player and TV monitor.
