

COSHH

Course Description

COSHH is the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1988. They are a series of statutory Regulations made under the framework of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974. The Regulations are aimed at protecting people against risks to their health arising from exposure to substances hazardous to health. The risks may be immediate or delayed in their effect. COSHH applies to substances which are used or produced at – or as a result of work processes.

The Regulations came into force on the 1st October 1989, they have obligations for employers, employees and the self-employed.
