

Chainsaw Maintenance & Cross Cutting Course 20-03

Course Description

Suitable for the novice operator who wishes to maintain and operate chainsaws for crosscutting only. This two day training course prepares the trainee to take the City and Guilds independent assessment.

Content

- State and identify the necessary clothing required and locate the various standard marks
- Identify safety features on a chainsaw
- Maintain the guide bar and sharpen chains to manufacturers specifications
- Carry out correctly all routine maintenance
- Prepare the chainsaw for use with the correct fuel and oil mix and chain lubrication
- Start the chainsaw from both cold and hot in a safe manner
- Cross cut timber accurately to required lengths in a safe manner and organise site safety

Equipment Required

Minimum requirement are chainsaw boots and chainsaw trousers - all other PPE and equipment can be supplied by Park Hill Training & Assessment Centre, but if the course is instructed out on another site then all facilities; warm room with vices, equipment such as saws, PPE, tool kits and timber to cross cut are required to be supplied by the trainees
