

Aerial Cutting of Trees with a Chainsaw Using Free-fall Techniques 21-08

This course is for Tree surgeons and Arborists. The course provides the knowledge and skill requirements for candidates to be assessed for the City and Guilds Certificate of Competence “Level 3 Award in Aerial Cutting of Trees with a Chainsaw Using Free-fall Techniques”.

- PPE
- Prepare chainsaw for use
- Cold/hot starting techniques
- Sending saw aloft
- General saw handling
- Use of chainsaw from rope and harness to remove medium sized lateral branches
- Use of slings
- How to free a trapped saw
- Target pruning
