

Chainsaw Maintenance & Operations – Occasional User 29-05

Course Description

Suitable for the novice operator who wishes to maintain and operate chainsaws for crosscutting and felling trees up to 150mm. This three day training course provides the knowledge and skill requirements for candidates to be assessed for the City and Guilds Certificate of Competence “Award in Chainsaw Maintenance and Operations – Occasional User”.

Content

- Be able to work safely
- Carry out essential maintenance to the engine, chain, drive and guidebar
- Carry out pre-start and safety check
- Prepare for felling and fell trees
- Take down a small hung up tree
- Cross-cut and stack timber on the ground of varying diameters to a given specification
- Remove branches safely
- Know how to work safely whilst carrying out chainsaw activities.
