

PA6AW - Safe Use of Hand Held Applicators – application in or near water

Course Description

This course prepares the trainee to take the City and Guilds PA6AW practical assessment, which combined with a PA1 & PA6A unit qualifies the operator in the legislative qualification Certificate of Competence in the Safe Use of Pesticides. By doing the PA6AW only (and not PA6A as well) it does mean that the candidate can only spray around the buffer zone of a water course and not on any open land.

Content - the course covers

- Legislation
- Label information
- Environmental risk assessment
- Nozzles and spray quality
- Types of nozzles
- Preparation of knapsack for use
- Calibration
- Site work
- Cleaning and decontamination of the applicator
- Other application methods
- Also preparation for applying a pesticide in or near water
- Knowledge of the principles of applying pesticide in or near water.
