

Two Day Level 3 Certificate of Technical Competence in Risk Assessment for Land Based Industries

Course Description:

If you are looking to work within the land-based sector, then this short qualification is aimed at you. The land-based sector has one of the worst fatal accident records of any major industrial sector. Contributory factors include a lack of basic training and competency, or deliberately ignoring safe working practices. There is a need for those working in the land-based industries to gain essential knowledge and skills in order to minimize harm to themselves and to improve attitudes and behaviour in the workplace. This unit aims to provide learners with an understanding of the risk assessment process and the associated legislation.

This qualification is primarily aimed at learners working within land-based industries with responsibility for carrying out the production and reviewing of risk and COSHH assessments. This qualification is suitable if you are 16 years old, or over. You could also progress to further learning and training in this area.

Aims:

This course is aimed at owner/managers within the land-based and environmental sector, freelance training consultants, forestry contractors, company directors or managers, Health & Safety supervisors, construction plant managers/supervisors, CPCs and land-based instructors, assessors, internal and external verifiers, TSV's, training providers, assessment centre managers, college tutors, etc. Included in the 3 day course fee are

- Park Hill Training Certificate of Attendance or option to take City & Guilds Assessment

Course times are 9.00am—4.30pm. All refreshments—lunch, teas & coffees are provided, trainees only need to bring suitable outdoor clothing for the practical sessions.

The two day course is followed by the City & Guilds assessment, which will include questions and practical tasks which will need to be completed in order to obtain the qualification.

Content:

This qualification covers the skills you will need to potentially progress to work within the land-based sector.

Mandatory content covers:

- understand health and safety legislation relevant to risk and COSHH assessments
- undertake the process of assessing risk in the land-based industries.

The assessment for this qualification will require you to achieve:

Practical tasks, theory and oral questioning
