

Felling and Processing Trees over 380mm

Course Description

This course is for people who are required to operate chainsaws to fell trees larger than the guide bar length and who have attended the basic chainsaw courses in this series, or their equivalent, and have the appropriate certification of pre-requisite (please see below). This training course is designed to prepare candidates for assessment for City and Guilds Certificate of Competence.

Content

- Introduction
- Maintenance re-cap
- Felling trees between 1 and 1.5 times guide bar length demonstration and takedown practice
- De-limbing including breakdown of large hardwood crowns
- Felling trees up to 2 time guide bar length (760mm)
- Takedown including use of hand winches
- Cross-cutting up to 2 times guide bar length.

Equipment Required

Minimum requirement are chainsaw boots and chainsaw trousers & winches - all other PPE and equipment can be supplied by Park Hill Training & Assessment Centre, but if the course is instructed out on another site then all facilities; warm room with vices, equipment such as saws, winch, PPE, tool kits and suitable trees are required to be supplied by the Trainees.
