

Aluminium Phosphide (Gassing)

This course prepares the trainee to take the City and Guilds practical assessment.

One Day Training with assessment to follow on a separate day.

The course covers...

- Understand what Aluminium Phosphide is and how to use it within the current legislative framework
- Understand when, where and against which target pests these products are used without harming the environment and/or non-target species
- Understand the significance of the product container
- Safe storage and transport
- Know how to avoid exposure to yourself, others and the environment
- Be aware of first aid measures in the event of exposure
- Know how to use both types of application equipment
- Know how to clean the application equipment and dispose of excess product and empty containers
- Deal with spillages or other incidents where exposure to gas could occur
- Keep correct records.

Aluminium Phosphide (Gassing)

Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply, tables and chairs for all trainees.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Area of land with evidence of mole, rabbits and rats.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- Application equipment suitable for Phostoxin and Talunex in good working order.
- Operator Manual for above
- Product labels and safety data sheets for Phostoxin and Talunex.
- Spade
- Probe for locating underground runs
- Markers for application sites.
- Aluminium Phosphide substitute for Phostoxin and Talunex product.
- PPE for all trainees to include protective coveralls e.g. DuPont Tyvek Type 4/5 5/6, wellington boots, full face respirator with the following filters FFP3 & B1 or B2 & nitrile gloves.

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.
