This course prepares the trainee to take the City and Guilds practical assessment.

Three Day Training with assessment to follow on a separate day.

The course covers...

- Introduction
- Maintenance re-cap
- Felling trees between 1 and 1.5 times guide bar length demonstration and takedown practice
- De-limbing including breakdown of large hardwood crowns
- Felling trees up to 2 time guide bar length (760mm)
- Takedown including use of hand winches
- Cross-cutting up to 2 times guide bar length.

Equipment

For Park Hill Training courses minimal requirement is chainsaw in good safe working order with tool kit, chainsaw boots, trousers, helmet and suitable gloves, spec on next page.

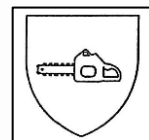
Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean, well-lit workshop, heated if necessary with chairs & tables/benches.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Woodland planted around 20-25 years ago is ideal with live trees over 380mm (15 inches) in diameter at felling height close enough together to be able to hang one tree on another. Average 6 trees per trainee per course.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- A bench vice available for each trainee.
- At least 1 chainsaw per trainee with up to 15 inch guide bar complete with safety labels as per AFAG Guide 301 and in good condition.
- Operator manual.
- Equipment must comply with PUWER Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations.
- Extra fuel.
- Felling levers.
- Trifor winch or similar (lift capacity at least 3200kgs), cables, shackles and ropes.
- Toolkits - in general spanners and screwdrivers, flat and pozidrive, and filing kit for sharpening.
- Warning notices.
- PPE for all Trainees. Standards as per HSE guidelines [here](#) to include
 - Chainsaw boots*
 - Chainsaw trousers*
 - Helmets
 - Visors
 - Ear defenders
 - Gloves*
 - Suitable waterproof outdoor work wear
 - Personal First Aid Kit
- * These items should carry the CE Chainsaw Logo (right)



Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment or taken at the time of the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.
