

# NSTS Fertiliser Spreader Examiner

This course has been designed to help you understand how the spreader works and help you test its performance and efficiency by using the approved NSTS testing scheme. Although this is not currently required by legislation, there is an increasing demand due to pressure from Quality Assurance schemes and NVQ requirements for fertiliser spreaders to be tested.

Trainees are prepared to take the City and Guilds practical assessment which, when successfully completed will allow them to become an examiner.

Two Day Training with assessment to follow on a separate day, when completed alongside as the Pellet Applicator Testing we will endeavour to organise all assessments for the same day.
