

NSTS Pellet Applicator Examiner

This course has been designed to help you understand how the applicator works and help you test its performance and efficiency by using the approved NSTS testing scheme. The requirement for testing has been brought about by the Sustainable Use Directive which requires that vehicle mounted slug pellet applicators applying pesticides are examined by 26.11.16 and every 6 years thereafter.

Trainees are prepared to take the City and Guilds practical assessment which, when successfully completed will allow them to become an examiner.

One Day Training with assessment to follow on a separate day, when completed alongside the Fertiliser Applicator Testing we will endeavour to organise all assessments on the same day.
