Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

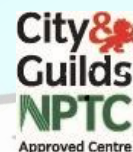
- For theory sessions: dry, clean and well-lit workshop, heated if necessary, free from flammables.
- Well ventilated workplace or Local Exhaust Ventilation unit available
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required, in in good condition

- Oxy-Acetylene cutter
- Oxygen Cylinder
- Acetylene Cylinder
- Regulators and flashback arrestors for each cylinder, all inspected or new within the past 3 years (or before the expiry date if marked on each)
- Operator manual.
- Equipment must comply with PUWER Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations and the Electricity at Work Regulations.
- Gas hoses should be in good condition (red for acetylene & blue for oxygen)
- An appropriate toolkit for machine being used for training.
- Selection of oxy acetylene cutting nozzles
- Plenty of clean steel off cuts of different thicknesses
- PPE for all Trainees
 - Steel toe-capped work boots
 - Gas cutting goggles
 - Gauntlets
 - Overalls
 - Local Exhaust Ventilation unit, if workplace is not well ventilated

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
