

# Chainsaw Maintenance & Cross Cutting REFRESHER

This course is for trainees who have already achieved Chainsaw Maintenance and Cross Cutting, refresher training is advised every 3 years – 5 years depending on your chainsaw use.

The course recaps...

- State and identify the necessary clothing required and locate the various standard marks
- Identify safety features on a chainsaw
- Maintain the guide bar and sharpen chains to manufacturers specifications
- Carry out correctly all routine maintenance
- Prepare the chainsaw for use with the correct fuel and oil mix and chain lubrication
- Start the chainsaw from both cold and hot in a safe manner
- Cross cut timber accurately to required lengths in a safe manner and organise site safety

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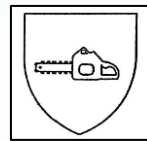
## Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

### Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean, warm room with power supply with chairs & tables.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Pieces of timber at least 6 feet in length and up to 8 - 15 inches in diameter suitable for crosscutting.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

### Equipment Required

- A bench vice available for each trainee.
- At least 1 chainsaw per trainee with up to 15 inch guide bar complete with safety labels as per AFAG Guide 301 and in good condition.
- Operator manual.
- Equipment must comply with PUWER Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations.
- Extra fuel.
- Toolkits - in general spanners and screwdrivers, flat and pozidrive, and filing kit for sharpening.
- Warning notices
- PPE for all Trainees. Standards as per HSE guidelines [here](#) to include
  - Chainsaw boots\*
  - Chainsaw trousers\*
  - Helmets
  - Visors
  - Ear defenders
  - Gloves\*
  - Suitable waterproof outdoor work wear
  - Personal First Aid Kit
- \* These items should carry the CE Chainsaw Logo (right)



### Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the training if a LANTRA course which includes a Skills ID Card is being completed, otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.



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
