Equipment

For Park Hill Training courses minimal requirement are Face Shield, Bib apron (over boiler suit) or waterproof coat (PVC or nitrile), Gloves (Non-lined or flock-lined, PVC or nitrile, heavy duty gauntlet style - 0.5 mm thick and at least 300 mm long), Waterproof leggings/trousers (PVC or nitrile to be worn outside your boots) and Wellington boots. All equipment is to be in good safe working order with no rips or tears. Course requirements are listed on the next page for courses taken on your site.

Safe Use of Sheep Dip

Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

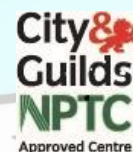
- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply and tables and chairs for all trainees.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- A suitable dip bath.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- PPE for all trainees to include:
 - Face Shield (when handling dip concentrate)
 - Bib apron (over boiler suit) or waterproof coat (PVC or nitrile) without rips or tears
 - Gloves (Non-lined or flock-lined, PVC or nitrile, heavy duty gauntlet style
 - 0.5 mm thick and at least 300 mm long) without rips or tears
 - Waterproof leggings/trousers (PVC or nitrile to be worn outside your boots) without rips or tears
 - Wellington boots
- Sheep dip, mobile or static. **Not a sheep shower as this product is not licensed to be used in one.**
- Race or hurdles nearby to be set up in a way which can be discussed during the training/assessment.
- Water supply

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later
