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Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply and tables and chairs for all trainees.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Suitable area of ground for manoeuvring, hitching a trailer and implements.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- At least 1 tractor between 2 trainees which is in good working order.
- Equipment must comply with PUWER Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations.
- Tipping trailer, PTO & hydraulic implements, whichever are required,
- Operator manual.
- Extra fuel.
- An appropriate toolkit.
- PPE for all Trainees
 - Steel toe-capped work boots
 - Ear defenders if applicable
 - Gloves
 - Suitable waterproof outdoor work wear.

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.



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
