# Transport of Animals – Long Journey

## Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

### Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply and tables and chairs for all trainees for theory sessions.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

### Equipment Required

- Suitable animal species for loading in a separate area (crate, pen, halter, muzzle, hutch etc.) one animal per person, or a group of animals to avoid unnecessary stress.
- Safe restraining equipment if necessary
- Trainees must wear suitable outdoor clothing and any PPE i.e. riding hat for horses.
- Suitable carrier/ trailer & vehicle in good safe working order
- Trainee must hold the correct driving licence; B+E for trailers etc.

### Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.
