- State legal safety points applicable to veterinary medicines
- Identify hazards and assess risks associated with veterinary medicines and plan for controlling these risks
- Plan suitable transport and storage facilities and supervise their use
- Plan and supervise the disposal of clinical and pharmaceutical waste
- Plan for modification of regime
- Develop a recording system for the use of veterinary medicines

Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply and tables and chairs for all trainees for theory sessions.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required
