VENUE REQUIREMENTS (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean, well-lit workshop, heated if necessary with chairs & tables/benches
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Area with material to be blown/ vacuumed.
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- At least 1 leaf blower between 2 trainees which is in good condition.
- Operator manual.
- Equipment must comply with PUWER Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations.
- Leaf blower spares, whichever are required.
- Extra fuel.
- Toolkits - in general spanners and screwdrivers, flat and pozidrive.
- PPE for all trainees to include
 - Steel toe capped boots
 - Helmets
 - Visors – if mesh then goggles will also be required.
 - Ear defenders
 - Gloves
 - Suitable waterproof outdoor work wear

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- We require one passport sized photograph of the candidate to be supplied electronically before the assessment otherwise extra costs will be incurred to provide an ID card later.
