Safe Use of Pesticides & Hand Held Applicator Refresher

Venue Requirements (if course is at your site)

Room/ Area Required

- For theory sessions: A dry, clean and warm room with power supply, tables and chairs for all trainees.
- Flipchart or whiteboard and marker pens.
- Area of grass suitable for spraying with water
- Washroom and toilet facilities.
- First Aid Equipment.
- Fire Extinguisher.

Equipment Required

- A knapsack per trainee complete with safety labels in good working condition.
- Operator manual.
- Measuring jugs.
- Measuring tapes.
- Markers for areas.
- Water supply.
- PPE for all trainees to include protective coveralls e.g. DuPont Tyvek Type 4/5 5/6, wellington boots, visors & nitrile gloves.

Other Requirements

- Upon arrival on site the instructor may postpone the training or assessment if the equipment or site are unsuitable. Payment will still be due and there will be an extra cost for the rescheduled day.
- All trainees must be fit enough for the training or assessment.
- Trainees must already hold Safe use of Pesticides and Safe use of Hand Held Applicator qualifications
